NT Under 14s Malaysian Tour

It was a great honour to be asked to be the assistant coach for the NT's Under 14 Malaysian tour to play in the Presidents Cup played in Ipoh and then to take on a combined team KL Saracens on the last Tuesday of the tour in Kuala Lumpur.

It was a very excited and nervous group of boys who started training on the 17th September. With 35 talented players coming from all NT clubs it was interesting to see rival players training as one and to see the friendships that have formed since is amazing.

We played a practice match against the Gove team who came over to Darwin on the 3rd and 4th October, which was the first time both these teams played together. It was an interesting two matches to watch.

The team selection was on the 9th October. It was hard to pick a team due to the talent that exists across all the players, but in the end there could only be 23 players in the squad. Hone Edwards (Dragons) was selected as captain and two players were also selected from the Gove team. Players selected from Palmerston were Hamish Martin (vice-captain), Tai Terupo and Wayne Bilston.

With the team finalised it was full steam ahead with the boys putting in 100% at the remaining training sessions and ensuring that passports etc. were all sorted out. The NTRU did a marvellous job with the organisation and planning of the whole event with a lot of time and effort invested in the tour.

The tour itinerary was as follows:

Thursday 7 November 2013

Depart from Darwin direct to Kuala Lumpur and travel from Kuala Lumpur to Ipoh. We all stayed at the host school S.T.A.R Ipoh which is a boarding school with around 600 students.
