**again.** Before I ask for subs for the season have a look at why we need to charge. I've set out below a brief breakdown of our running costs for a single senior team. This is not exhaustive and there are definitely other costs involved.

TOTAL	\$4000
Game costs (for season)	\$1500
NTRU affiliation	\$250
Jerseys	\$1250
ARU insurance	\$1000

You can see that even if 20 players from each team pay their subs of \$120 we only collect \$2400 of this and there are many other hidden costs. Rugby has become an expensive game. We just ask that you help out your club by being a prompt payer who doesn't have to be chased.

This season:

Players	\$120
Non players	\$30

These may be revised as we come to terms with other rising costs around us. (All gear is separate this year. *See Croc Shop for prices.*)

# Why you should have your own insurance.

Last season was not a happy one for several players who caught infections or were injured and lost time at work. The ARU insurance doesn't help much in this way. It kicks in after 28 days and even then doesn't pay much. Also some medication and certainly physiotherapy may not be claimable.
