CODE OF CONDUCT DURING MATCHES:

Following the recent citing of a member, members are asked to stick strictly to the Club's Code of Conduct:

- Players should not make any comment to the referee or fellow players regarding how he (the referee) is interpreting the laws of the game.
- The only on-field player to speak to the referee is the on-field captain and he should speak to the referee only to ask for clarification with regard to a decision taken by the referee. At no stage should an argument be entered into with the referee. If the captain is dissatisfied with the clarification given, he should ask the team manager to record this dissatisfaction in the match report.
- Coaches, managers and bench players should at no time make any comments directed at or likely to be overheard by match officials. Note should be made of any concerns and these should be recorded in the match report.

• At no stage should players, coaches or managers express dissent towards decisions taken by match officials. Any disagreements or concerns should be recorded in the match report.

• Other Club officials, not directly involved with the team, should try to ensure that all Palmerston supporters are aware of this code of conduct and that the Club hopes they will adhere to the same procedure as the players, coaches and managers.
